Donkey Rattle





This classical effect instrument originates from the original Donkey Rattle, a set of donkey's teeth, producing rattling sounds. The mechanical type consists of a shackle with a wood-en knob and resonating box. It has a sophisticated interior for a rattling sound effect

Very similar is the handy Flexaton (= flex-a-tone). You can play simple rhythmic patterns with it. While flexing the sheet metal with the thumb you create glissandi. When shaken the two balls beat against the metal.
